

Use of Data Relating to Driving Licence Verification Service

Fleet Efficiency Ltd is registered under the Data Protection Act 1998 for the keeping of records relating to business activities, including personal details of customers (drivers). We do not pass this information to third parties other than where it is required by subcontractors to enable them to carry out tasks related to management of the customer's fleet.

Where a customer has chosen the Driving Licence Verification Service, drivers are required to complete a mandate, which authorises the Driver & Vehicle Licensing Agency to supply information to Fleet Efficiency Ltd. The information supplied is the same as that displayed on the Driver's licence and will relate to driving entitlement, endorsements and disqualifications. The DVLA will not supply medical information, apart from the requirement for eye correction.

Fleet Efficiency Ltd holds information supplied by the DVLA in a database, which is used to provide reports to the Driver's employer and to prepare requests for future licence checks.

Access to the database is restricted to authorised personnel and controlled by user IDs and passwords, which are changed regularly, at both operating system and application level.

Driving licence information is used solely to provide a verification service to check that drivers have valid licences and for no other purpose.
